
CHAPTER 27: ARABIAN HORSE AMERICA PROGRAMS

All Arabian Horse Association members (Refer to Chapter 7.) will be able to participate in all facets of Arabian Horse America online Incentive Programs and be recognized for their achievements.

If you are currently riding and competing with your horse outside of AHA Recognized shows, these Incentive Programs are designed for you. From USDF Dressage to local open shows or just getting out and having fun on your horse, you can join any or all of the following programs and receive awards for reaching set goals.

The following programs are online at www.ArabianHorseAmerica.com/IncentivePrograms and the procedures and criteria can be found on the website.

Program participants are defined as individual riders who may ride any number of Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian horses registered with the Arabian Horse Association or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry.

Participants must fill out an AHA Incentive Program Application online to join.

After you have enrolled in the program you will have chosen a User ID and PIN with which you may access and update your account at any time online.

No hours, miles or points can be recorded before enrollment.

ARTICLE 2701. FREQUENT RIDER PROGRAM

The Frequent Rider Program (FRP) is an online program that rewards riders for every hour that they spend on the back of their horse in non-competitive activities. Participants can be on the trail, do ranch work, ride in parades, take riding lessons, train under saddle, or just ride for pleasure.

Log on to the Arabian Horse America website to view required criteria and recording procedures.

When an FRP milestone, is reached, participants will receive the appropriate award or recognition.

Note: The Recreational Riding Program will be combined with the Frequent Rider Program in 2004. (BOD 1/03)

ARTICLE 2702. COMPETITIVE DISTANCE PROGRAM

The Competitive Distance Program (CDP) is an online program that promotes and rewards riders for the miles they spend competing in distance riding events.

Log on to Arabian Horse America website to view accepted ride organizations and minimum miles required for each type of ride to count.

When competitors reach a CDP milestone, participants will receive the appropriate award or recognition.

Note: This program may be merged with the Distance Award Program for 2004.

ARTICLE 2703. OPEN-EVENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM (OEIP)

The Open Event Incentive Program (OEIP) is an online program that rewards riders and horses who participate in national all-breed events recognized by national organizations outside the Arabian Community and open shows sponsored by local clubs, saddle clubs and other breed associations.

Horses used in these competitions will automatically have their accomplishments recorded in their horse's permanent event record.

When competitors reach each major point milestone, they will receive the appropriate award or recognition.

At the end of each calendar year, one high point rider from each event category who meets the required criteria will receive a trophy, plus a short story and photo on the Arabian Horse America website.
