
CHAPTER 17: ARABIAN COMMUNITY SHOWS (ACS)

For all membership requirements refer to Chapter 7 and Article 1701.3.

The Arabian Community Shows (ACS) program is designed as an affordable AHA Recognized Show venue within the Arabian Horse community that gives novice and amateur competitors an Arabian Horse show circuit where they can compete and have their accomplishments recognized. It is also outlined to establish a permanent performance record for horses competing at this level, thus creating more value for those horses and bringing the fun of showing back into the Arabian Horse Association.

ARTICLE 1701. INFORMATION AND SIGN-UP

1. Information on registering a new ACS as a Show Host can be found online at ArabianHorses.org under Competitions.
2. Information on approved ACS Shows in your area, logon to ArabianHorses.org and view the ACS Event Calendar under the Competitions or Arabian Community Shows menu.
3. Individual Membership in the Arabian Horse Association is required for inclusion in Arabian Community Shows award programs. An AHA Competition Card is not required.
4. Participants are not required to sign up for a specific ACS through AHA. Each individual ACS will establish the class lists and sign-up requirements.
5. For a copy of the Official Guidelines or to order a Show Host packet go to 'Competitions' on the Arabian Horse website or contact the Arabian Horse Association office.

ARTICLE 1702. ARABIAN COMMUNITY SHOWS AWARDS PROGRAMS

1. The ACS Awards Programs are specific to the ACS program only. Accumulated points for the ACS Year-end High Point and ACS Milestone Awards are not transferable and will not be used towards any other AHA programs, including Achievement Awards and Regional and National Qualifications.
2. At the end of each calendar year, a high point exhibitor from each category will receive a Year-end High Point award.
3. When an ACS Milestone is reached, participants will receive an award or recognition designated for that milestone.
4. Registered Arabians, Half-Arabians and Anglo-Arabians who place at an ACS will have their accomplishments recorded in their permanent Event Record in the online Arabian Horse DataSource world database, ArabDataSource.com.
